Bluemound: Child Proof Child Identification

Would you be prepared, if your child was ever lost or missing? The CHILD PROOF card puts all the information you'd need in case of an emergency. It's an instant police report and is meant to be carried by parents, guardians or other caregivers at all times. The card's vital information can be quickly uploaded to the AMBER ALERT by local authorities.

CHILD PROOF also provides a Student Card which is intended to be carried in a child's backpack - never worn or displayed on the child. The student card DOES NOT contain home address - only contact phone numbers necessary in case of an accident or emergency.

The CHILD PROOF card is also great for traveling when used as a 2nd form of ID. The back of both cards features your child's thumbprint.
